CSIR-CSIO is devoted to Research, Design and Development of Scientific & Industrial Instruments, Sensors and Systems. CSIR-CSIO invites applications from Indian Nationals only for filling up one post of Security Officer as per the details given below :

- (II) **Age Limit : 35 years (as on 13.05.2013)**
(Ex-Servicemen will be given age relaxation as per Govt. of India's Instructions)

Place of Posting CSIR-CSIO Chandigarh	Essential Educational Qualification : Ex-Servicemen-Short Service Commissioned Officer or Assistant Commandant from CRPF/BSF/ITBP etc. in the pay scale of Rs. 8000-13500 (pre-revised) with 05 years experience OR Ex-Servicemen-JCO (Subedar or higher rank) or equivalent rank in other paramilitary forces with minimum of 10 years experience in security. Desirable Qualification : Graduation with good verbal & written communication skill with knowledge of computers and modern fire fighting and security monitoring systems. Job Requirement : Overall supervision & maintenance of day-to-day security of CSIR-CSIO campus and handling other related tasks like fire fighting and safety of estate & buildings.

General Conditions :

1. The position carries Pay and Allowances at Central Government rates as applicable to the employees of Council stationed in Chandigarh. In addition, other benefits such as Leave Travel Concession and reimbursement of medical expenses are also available as per rules.
2. New Entrant will be governed by the "New Pension Scheme" based on defined Contributions for New entrants recruited in Central Government Services on or after 01.01.2014, as adopted by CSIR for its employees. However, persons selected from other Government Departments, Autonomous Bodies, Public Sector Undertakings, Central Universities working prior to 01.01.2004 & having Pensions Scheme on GOI pattern, will continue to be governed by the existing Pension Scheme i.e. CCS (Pension) Rules, 1972.
3. The date for determining the upper age limit/qualification/experience shall be the closing date prescribed for receipt of applications. Relaxation of age in respect of Ex-Servicemen will be as per Govt. of India orders issued from time to time.
4. Relaxation of 5 years in age will also be permissible to those who had ordinarily been domiciled in the Kashmir Division of the State of Jammu & Kashmir during the period from 01.01.1980 to 31.12.1989 subject to production of relevant certificate from concerned authority.
5. Those employed in Govt. Deptt./PSUs/Autonomous Bodies should send their applications through proper channel.
6. Mere fulfilment of the minimum prescribed qualification and experience will not vest any right on a candidate for being called for interview.
7. Since it may not be possible to call all the candidates for interview, a duly constituted Screening committee shall screen the applications. The decision of CSIR-CSIO in this regard will be final.
8. Incomplete, unsigned applications and those not accompanied with copies of certificates and application fee will be summarily rejected.
9. Canvassing in any form and/or bringing in any influence political or otherwise will be treated as a disqualification for the post.
