1. The engagement as a JRF in the project is purely on temporary basis maximum for the period of duration of the project. The engagement can be terminated by either side by giving one month's notice OR stipend in lieu thereof. It is not a CSIR-CSIO appointment and will not confer any right on the incumbent to any claim implicit or explicit on any position.
2. **Reservation:** As regards reservation, if all things are equal, SC/ST/OBC/PH candidates may be given preference over General candidates so as to ensure their representation.
3. **Medical Facilities** will be provided through CSIR-CSIO Dispensary.
4. **Registration for Ph.D:** The facility of Ph.D. registration shall be allowed to those JRF who have worked for a minimum period of two years and have at least cleared CSIR-UGC lectureship (NET), or GATE examination or published two papers in international peer reviewed journals.
5. Candidate should possess the required educational qualification / experience as on date of interview.
6. **Mode of Selection:** The candidates will be interviewed by the respective Selection Committee and panel will be prepared. The Panel so prepared will be utilized for engagement as JRF as and when requirement arises.
7. Relaxation of age for SC/ST - 5 years, OBC - 3 years, PH (SC/ST) – 10+5, PH (UR) - 10 years and Widows, Divorced women and women Judicially separated from their husband and who are not re-married and falls under the category of UR upto 35 years and SC/ST upto 40 years will be applicable as per GOI/CSIR instructions.
